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The mental disorder that is often experienced is schizophrenia, where the common symptom that is complained of is violent behavior. Violent behavior is. Mental disorder with violent behavior is a condition where a person commits an action that can harm physically, both to himself and others. (Malfasari et al., 2020). Violent behavior varies in each country, the highest was reported in Sweden with 42.90%, Indonesia in 2020, the prevalence of patients with violent behavior was reported at around 0.8% per 10,000 population or around 2 million people (Dinkes, 2020). There are many ways that can be done to control violent behavior in people with mental disorders, one of which is Snakes and Ladders Play Therapy. The purpose of writing this scientific work is to show an overview of nursing care for people with a nursing diagnosis of violent behavior using the case study method and providing nursing care using the nursing process approach. Based on the results of the assessment, a nursing diagnosis was established, namely violent behavior with interventions implementing SP 1-4. The snake and ladder game therapy was carried out for five days with an undetermined duration, with 2 meetings a day. The end result of the nursing care provided is that the patient can control violent behavior by using snakes and ladders therapy. Suggestions for room nurses to optimize the application of playing snakes and ladders therapy to control emotions in patients with Violent Behavior.
