ABSTRACT

Specific language impairment (SLI) is a language disorder that is not caused by neurological, sensory, intellectual, or other conditions that may be the cause of language difficulties. The main characteristics of children with SLI may be experiencing disturbances in the development of vocabulary, phonology, use of grammatical morphemes, syntactic constructions, and pragmatics. The purpose of this case study is to find out whether the extension method can improve the ability to name word levels. The case study was the management the extension method in case of developmental aphasia (specific language impairment) aged 3 years in the city of Padang.
